The On-line Training through NMCCS and ACES is now available!!!!!! This training is being made available for any of your GC members who may need to complete their mandatory (5) hours of GC training.

The cost of the training will be:

Good News About Charter Schools!

Last week, U.S. News & World Report's highly regarded Best High Schools ranking came out and, for the second consecutive year, Cottonwood Classical Preparatory School in Albuquerque was among the top 100 in the country – No. 67, in fact.

The rankings were determined using a combination factors including test scores, percentage of economically disadvantaged students, graduation rates, and other measures. Metrics used by the magazine to rank high schools are The second-highest ranked New Mexico school was another charter school, Albuquerque Institute of Math and Science, which was 276th. Five of the state's top 10 schools are charters.

East Mountain High School's debate team recently placed fifth in the world at the International Public Policy Forum, held in New York. Teams from 29 countries participated in the event.
