Facilities Maintenance

One of the many services provided by ACES is taking care of the maintenance of charter schools. This allows charter leaders to focus on educating students. While this initially takes care of minor repairs that need to be made, it quickly evolves into developing a preventative maintenance plan, providing a data base to track maintenance activities, and provides a single point of contact available to coordinate routine, emergency and preventive maintenance services. It can also include facility upgrades. Monthly meetings with ACES and charter school staff make certain there is a smooth coordination of efforts. All purchase orders and payments to contractors are made by ACES with monthly billings to the charter schools, reducing much of the paper work. All work meets the requirements of the procurement code. Contact Bruce or Max with additional questions or for a more personal onsite visit.

Huge Savings on Activity/Field Trips

Through a competitive bid process, ACES has awarded a contract to Herrera Coaches to provide huge discounts for ACES members on chartering buses for Activity/Field trips. The savings for ACES members over non-ACES members are: 11% savings on standard rates for a minimum trip; 50% savings per hour at 5 hours; 25% savings per mile; and, 11% savings for the coach rental.

The buses originate the trips from Albuquerque, Santa Fe, or Pojoaque. All a school needs to do is to call Martin (pronounced Marteen) Herrera at 505-270-1001 to schedule the bus. Herrera Coaches will bill the school directly. Purchasing of bus trips this way are covered by the Procurement Code. A copy of the Herrera Response is available on the ACES Website.
