Cooperative Purchase Agreement Partners (CPA)



That process includes submitting a proposal in response to a publicly solicited Request for Proposals published by ACES. The proposal is then evaluated by a team who determines if the proposal meets all the requirements of solicitation and offers charter school advantageous pricing.

School Security and Safety

The area of school security is of prime importance to ACES. However, we believe it must go beyond setting off an alarm when an intrusion occurs in the night. 
